## COVID-19 SAFETY BRIEFING



Brixworth Juniors Football Club require all teams to conduct the Covid-19 safety briefing with their team and spectators prior to commencing a training session or match.

- Visiting teams must read the BJFC risk assessment on our website, [Brixworth Juniors FC](#), prior to arrival. Alternatively, request a copy from the BJFC coach.
- Health check – Any person attending who has themselves, or a person with their household, has Covid-19 symptoms of a high temperature, a new persistent cough, loss or change to taste or smell or waiting for the results of a Covid-19 test must go home immediately & follow the latest government advice. Parents of children in age groups of under 11 and under must be asked on behalf of their child.
- No spectators. A maximum of 1 parent/carer per child may attend and is required to scan the displayed NHS Covid QR code.
- Toilet facilities will be available. Users are expected to leave the facility in a clean condition.
- Visiting coach is responsible for taking an attendance register of their own and storing the information securely for NHS Test & Trace purposes.
- Tier guidance to be followed relating to social distancing, numbers in spectator groups etc.
- Hands must be sanitised before putting up equipment and after putting it away.
- Non-players must not retrieve the ball with their hands when out of play.
- Coaches and match officials to avoid touching the ball.
- No spitting, shouting. Socially distanced goal celebrations only.
- Players must not share food or drinks.
- All players, coaches & officials to regularly sanitise hands, the very minimum at the start of the session/match and before departing. Players must sanitise in front of the coach.
- Maximum of 2 adults in the match day technical area.
- Everybody should leave the ground as quickly as possible after the session/match to avoid gatherings in groups.
